

Use of CellerateRX Surgical, Hydrolyzed Collagen Powder on Toes after a Lawn Mower Injury

Patient History & Treatment

A 44-year-old male ran over his foot with a lawn mower. Damaged bone was removed from the tips of the 1st and 2nd toes. 1/2 of a gram of CellerateRX Surgical powder was used inside each toe during surgery and a Deraspan artificial graft was applied on top. Surgery was done the same day as the injury. Treatment was final after 10 weeks.

06/15/15: 12 days post-op. A small amount of CellerateRX Surgical powder was applied.
